Subject: Re: School House Lane and RT 1

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Concord Council Member Rankin,

These are questions posed in January of 2021 that Council President Pileggi stated he had not heard until August 31st. I am concerned that the voices of some citizens are not being heard.

PennDot concluded a stop light was not feasible. Can we pursue the other 3 questions posed?

- 1) Can a right turn lane be added for Southbound RT1 traffic making a right turn on to School House Lane?
- 2) There is significant commercial heavy equipment vehicle traffic from 139 School House Lane. Often dump trucks are towing long trailers, and the combination of dump truck and trailer is over 40 feet long. The intersection is not designed to handle the daily volume of these large commercial vehicles. Can the residential property owner who goes by the family name of "139 School House Lane, LLC." be directed to not use the RT1 and School House Lane intersection for their commercial business commuting?
- 3) Can the prison staff be directed not to use School House Lane for their daily commutes?
